Have you seen the Chagal stained glass windows in the chapel of Hadassah Hospital Jerusalem? Did you know that we have our own magnificent stained glass windows right here in Buffalo, created by amazing local artist, and Hadassah member, Jane Jacobson. In this special Hadassah program Jane will tell us about the novel architectural placement of her windows from the original Beth Tzedek on Getzville Rd. to the new Temple Beth Tzedek on North Forest.

Jane is a member of the American Glass Guild and creates from her home-based studio in Buffalo. After growing up in Philadelphia and pursuing her fine arts degree at Tyler School of Art, she studied with various glass artists and did brief internships at the York Glazier's Trust in England and the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York to study conservation techniques. She has been working in the medium for over 35 years.
